## **Literacy**

#### Reading:

This term we will be continue to use the CAFE and Daily 5 Reading approach, focusing on building students reading comprehension, accuracy, fluency, and expression. We will continue working through "Holes" by Louis Sachar.

#### Writing:

We will be using the 7 Steps to Writing Success to enhance our information texts, recounts and biographies.

We will continue to implement The **SMART Spelling** approach each week.

### Inquiry

This term we will learn about the concept of **change** through the lens of **Australian history**.

We will be studying the causes and reasons why people migrated from Europe and Asia.

We will create a 'Museum in Motion' where we will explore important events, and learn about the pioneers who shaped our country.

#### **Mathematics**

The areas we intend to cover this term in Mathematics include:

**Fractions and decimals:** We will be comparing fractions and solving problems involving the addition and subtraction of fractions. We will also be finding fractions of a quantity.

Decimals: We will be adding and subtracting decimals,I multiplying decimals by whole numbers, and multiplying andI dividing decimals by powers of ten.

**Measurement:** We will be converting between common metric units of length, mass and capacity.

Statistics and data: We will plan, collect, analyse and interpret a range of qualitative and quantitative data.



## Religion

This term we will looking at the notions of solidarity and community while unpacking the concept of change in the church. We will explore the early Catholic Church in Australia, how it has evolved, and future directions.
